

**Call for Papers:**  
**Science and Technology Policy in Asia**  
**Paper Competition/Policy Workshop/Publication**  
**Abstracts due: May 15, 2013**  
**Final Papers due: June 19, 2013**

To encourage a new generation of science and technology policy makers and promote early career research, Korea Institute of Science and Technology Evaluation and Planning (**KISTEP**) is opening the forth paper competition. The competition seeks paper submissions for an upcoming **policy workshop on ‘Science and Technology Policy in Asia’**. Winning papers will be published in *Asian Research Policy* published by KISTEP and selected authors will be invited to present their papers in a policy workshop to be held in Seoul, Republic of Korea in fall of 2013.

The topics of interest include but are not limited to:

- **R&D Management**
- **Technology Management/Policy/Strategy**
- **Competence/Capability (e.g. core, dynamic)**
- **R&D Program/Innovation Policy Evaluation**
- **Innovation Management/Policy/Strategy**
- **Knowledge (creation, transfer, exploitation etc.)**
- **System(s) of Innovation (national, regional etc.)**
- **Learning (e.g. organizational) and Experimentation**
- **Product and Process Development**
- **Industrial Clusters**

※ Paper should be policy-based and solutions-oriented and also should include trend analysis of Asian countries’ science and technology policy, case studies, analytical methodology research, and etc. Papers from various disciplines and/or interdisciplinary perspectives are appropriate as long as the papers stick to the selected topic stated above. More importantly, any paper either published or filed in other journals cannot be submitted in this competition. ## Process and Timeline

- ◆ **Eligibility** - This call for papers is directed at scholars (PhD level or above).
- ◆ **Abstract Submission**
  - Abstracts (max 200 words) and a brief CV will be submitted to the selection committee. Submissions should be sent to [joseph@kistep.re.kr](mailto:joseph@kistep.re.kr) by **May 15, 2013**. After submissions of abstracts, format of final version will be given.
  - Abstracts should contain a title, author name, affiliation, and paper description, key words (3~5), and e-mail address and specify which of the topical areas listed above the paper will most directly address.
- ◆ **Full Paper Format and Submission**
  - Full papers should be submitted to the selection of committee by **June 19, 2012**. Submissions should be sent to [joseph@kistep.re.kr](mailto:joseph@kistep.re.kr)
  - Completed papers should be a maximum of 20 pages in length including appendixes (1.5-spaced, Times New Roman, 12pt) and utilize the style, spelling, usage, citation and illustration guidelines used by the American Psychological Association (APA) Manual.
- ◆ **Publication**
  - Approximately 3 of the submitted full papers will be selected for inclusion to be published by *Asian Research Policy*. The selection committee is composed of external experts (mostly from Editorial Board Members of *Asian Research Policy*). The committee will review papers, maintaining the anonymity of the authors.
  - Only accepted applicants will be notified in late July.
  - Publication of each selected paper is subject to review and will be contingent upon completion of suggested revisions by the authors, should they be requested by the selection committee. The final version of papers will be published between in late September.
  - The grand first prize winner will be given certificate of award and grant of \$5,000. Two runner-up prize winners will also be given certificate of award and grant of \$2,000.
- ◆ **Policy Workshop**
  - 2-3 of the authors selected for publication will be invited to Seoul, Republic of Korea to participate in a “policy workshop” that will bring together a small group of academics, policy makers and students for an interactive discussion of science and technology policy in Asia.
  - Workshop invitees will be provided with transportation and accommodation costs.
